MISSION STATEMENT

The Southeast Wisconsin Incident Management Team, Inc. (SEW IMT) assists local jurisdictions with the management of an incident, exercise or a preplanned event to achieve an efficient, safe and effective response. The SEW IMT provides personnel from across the public safety spectrum who are qualified, trained, organized, equipped, and prepared to support any hazards facing a local agency. This support can be in an advisory/assistant role or as a member of the Incident. Command Structure or Emergency Operations Center (EOC). The team remains flexible, scalable and fluid in meeting the needs of local requesting agencies; be they single resources or the entire team. The team uses the Incident Command System, in accordance with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the National Preparedness System (NPS). The SEW IMT is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization eligible to receive tax deductible donations to a charitable organization.

EQUIPMENT

The SEW IMT is fully equipped to handle most missions or tasks (all-hazards). The team has a response trailer with laptop computers, chairs, generator, signs, vests and "go-bags" for each IMT member.

COSTS

The deployment of SEW IMT assets is free of charge under mutual aid and volunteer assistance laws.

MISSIONS

The types of missions the SEW IMT can perform are evaluation/controllers, facilitation, planning or assistance with managing a major emergency, exercise or a special event for any agency in Southeast Wisconsin. When requested, some of the missions the SEW IMT can assist with are:

- ✓ Preparedness planning for all hazards
- ✓ Table-top, functional or full-scale exercise facilitation
- ✓ Pre-planned event coordination
- ✓ Emergency response to major events or disasters
- ✓ Emergency Operations Center (EOC) management and process facilitation

TASKS

Some of the tasks with which the SEW IMT can **provide assistance**:

- ✓ Establishing and maintaining the Incident Command System
- ✓ Assisting with command, operations, logistics, planning or finance/administration, Public Information, Liaison or Safety functions
- ✓ Building/updating Incident Action Plans (IAP)
- ✓ Managing personnel accountability and tracking
- ✓ Running incident check-in or the Staging Area
- ✓ Managing Volunteers or Donations
- ✓ Facilitate on-scene communications for multiple agencies
- ✓ Establishing or facilitating the Public Information function or a Joint Information Center
- ✓ Damage Assessment
